The eight days of Hanukkah are times of rejoicing over a battle won and freedom gained. *Hallel*, or praise, is said during the morning prayer, and grace is said after each meal. Lighting the menorah or *hanukkiah* is part of the Hanukkah celebration. The menorah holds nine candles. Eight candles represent the eight days of Hanukkah and the ninth, the *shamash* (leader or head), is used to light the other candles.
